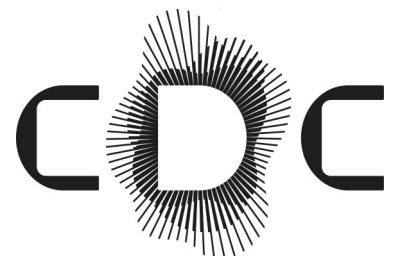

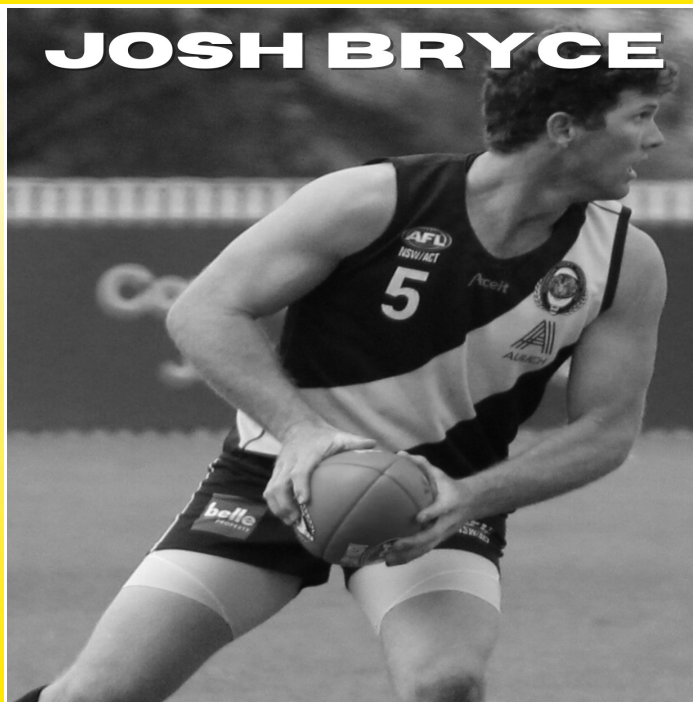

# 100 Years of Tigers Footy!

“OUR HISTORY FROM 1925 - BLAST FROM THE PAST MOMENTS”

#25 “Who said it’s just a game?”

History shows that the 1994 Grand Final was won by Ainslie, but Queanbeyan was justifiable disappointed with the end result. Queanbeyan had comfortably beaten Ainslie in the last round game and again in the second semi-final. Queanbeyan were favourites to take their fifth premiership in ten years and after leading by 32 points at first break it seemed just a matter of how much the Tigers would win by; however it was not to be.

For three consecutive years the Tigers lost a leading player during the final’s series through the send-off rule and the 1994 GF was no exception with the 1994 Mulrooney medallist, ACTAFL Player of the year and the Tigers assistant coach Michael Kennedy sent off for alleged misconduct of swearing. In addition, the free kick count was Ainslie 34 to Queanbeyan 13, and 50 metre penalties went to Ainslie 3 (2 goals) to Queanbeyan 0.

Subsequently the Club’s officials expressed their strong concern to the ACTAFL regarding the quality of the umpiring and the Leagues officials took note of these concerns and overhauled the structure of the controlling body of the umpires, giving greater emphasis to umpire training and consistency of decision making.

This year saw the start of the AUSKICK program in Queanbeyan, a program for 5 to 8-year-old children. Some positive marketing saw 140 children join the five-week program!



A discouraging sight. The end is near for the Tigers 1994 campaign, with Michael Kennedy in the interchange box along side Captain Tony Wynd. Kennedy had been sent from the field in the third quarter by Umpire Andrew Toy for “swearing” whilst Wynd had suffered a shoulder injury in a prior match which he again injured during the course of the Grand Final. Standing on the left hand side of the box is the Tigers Conditioner Rochelle Nichols - the first female to be actively involved with the Tigers on field commitments.

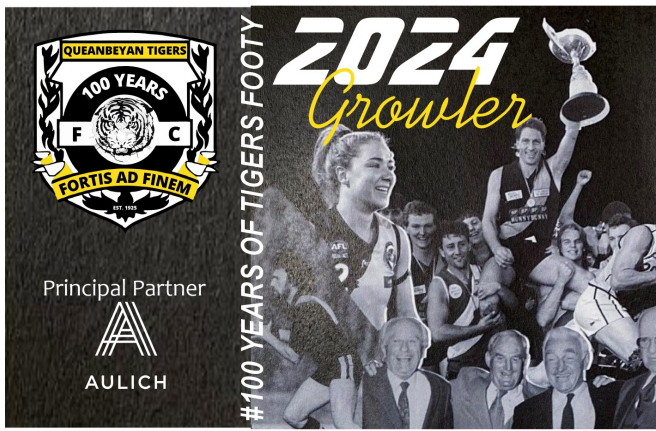
